

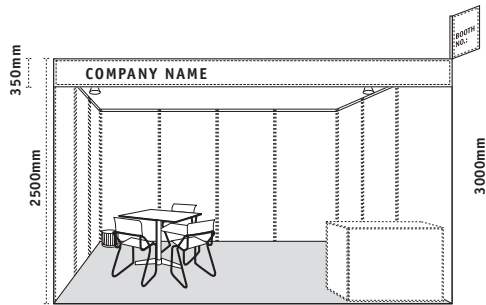

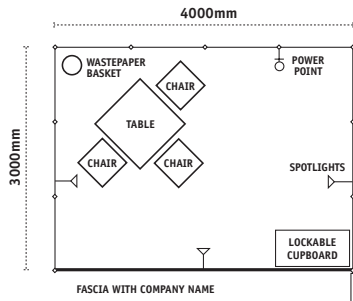

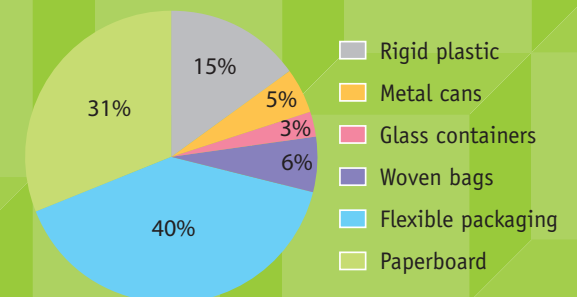
WHY Indonesia

- GDP growth of 5.9% in 2010 and with projected growths of 6% in 2011, 6.4% in 2012, before expanding by 6.3% a year on an average in 2013 - 15.
- 4th most populous nation in the world with over 240 million inhabitants.
- Increasing middle class has fueled demand for food, beverage, cosmetics, pharmaceutical, household chemicals and other consumer products.

Bright future for the packaging industry

- Indonesia's packaging industry market is expected to reach US\$4.6 billion in 2011 from US\$4.1 billion in 2010.
- Global demand for packaging machinery is projected to expand 4.9 percent in 2011. Sales conditions are expected to be strong in Indonesia surpassing its performance in 2009, as the third largest importer of packaging machinery ahead of Japan.
- The food processing industry valued at approximately US\$42 billion offers significant market opportunities for the food packaging industry.
